Domaine Lafage 2015 "Bastide Miraflores" Cotes Catalanes (France)

This wine is almost too good to be true. It's a ripe, sexy, heady beauty that exhibits a deep, purple color as well as killer notes of smoked meats, chocolate, blackberry and black raspberries. Deep, unctuous, open knit and layered, it continues to change in the glass, has a seamless and silky profile, and not a hard edge to be found. It's a sensational value that needs to be tasted to be believed. Drink it anytime over the coming 2-4 years.

Oxford Landing 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon (Australia)

This shows some fresh blackcurrant character as well as lavender and some light peppermint. Medium body, fine-grained tannins and a herbal finish. A little herbaceous. Drink now. Screw cap.

Fresh cherry and plum notes are laced with a light anise hint and a dash of sweet toast.

Headly aromas like wood smoke, black pepper and new rubber tire lead to equally peppery, smoky flavors and a firm, nicely tannic texture. The wine is medium to full bodied and well concentrated.

Enrique Mendoza 2014 "La Tremenda" Monastrell/Alicante (Spain)

The 2014 feels very tender, it has the esparto grass austerity of the stony vineyards with the chalky soils and a myriad of Mediterranean herbs. They used some stems for the fermentation, which added a fine thread and makes it subtly textured. It has the dusty tannins and the saline tastiness of the limestone soils. It represents a superb value and a great introduction to the Monastrell from Alicante; the price is hard to believe.
