Mas Des Bressades 2015 "Cuvee Tradition" Syrah/Grenache (France)



This wine is a perennial overachiever, but the 2015 is even more so than usual. The aromas are bold and ripe, offering notes of cherries, ample garrigue and hints of tar. The wine is rich and velvety on the palate, folding in notes of chocolate, baking spices, plum and dried herbs.

Coltibuono 2015 "Cetamura" Chianti (Italy)
Aromas of cherries and dried berries with hints of lemon. Medium body, bright acidity and delicious fruit. Nicely done considering the difficulty of the vintage. A blend of sangiovese and canaiolo. Drink now.

Muga 2016 Rioja Rosado (Spain)
This lively rosé rides energetic citrusy acidity to deliver focus and freshness. Cherry and red plum flavors have depth, and leafy and smoky notes add interest. Drink now.

3 Rings 2014 Shiraz (Australia)
Notes of wild herbs bring added interest to this wine's cherry fruit. It's medium-full in size and weight, with supple tannins and a long, minty finish. It's big and ripe enough to be served on its own, yet should also work with lamb or beef.

A mix of black cherry, floral and earth flavors, this red leans toward the savory side but gains purity with air. Resonates pleasantly on the finish. Drink now through 2019.
