Stephane Ogier 2014 Le Temps Est Venu Cotes du Rhone (France)

A blend of 60% Grenache and 40% Syrah that was vinified and aged all in concrete -- and bottled early -- the 2014 Cotes du Rhone le Temps Est Venu comes from the Plan de Dieu and Visan AOCs. Medium-bodied, supple, elegant and downright sexy, with impressive notes of peppery herbs, raspberries, dried flowers and violets, it shows the forward nature of the vintage, yet has solid sweetness of fruit and plenty of charm. Drink it anytime over the coming 5-7 years.

Domaine Bousquet 2015 Malbec (Argentina)
Punchy and grapy on the nose, this bright Malbec feels edgy and rubbery. Flavors of spicy black cherry and kirsch finish solidly, with a hint of chocolate flavor.

Yalumba 2015 "Y Series" Chardonnay (Australia)
The 2015 Chardonnay Y Series Unwooded gives clean, unadulterated apple and peach notes with a gentle grapefruit lift. Light to medium-bodied, crisp and lively in the mouth, it offers straight-up delicious stone fruit flavors and good length. Great value Chardonnay!

Principi di Butera 2015 Nero d'Avola (Italy)
Good full ruby-red. Lively, perfumed aromas and flavors of blackberry, violet and fresh herbs. Not especially large-scaled but intensely flavored and well delineated, offering a nice combination of sweetness and liveliness. Finishes with noble tannins and a delightful violet topnote. One of the best (most flavorful and precise) entry-level Sicilian wines I have ever tasted from the Zonin group.

Ravines 2015 Dry Riesling (New York)
Still youthfully tight, this brims with tension as the long, mineral spine holds the core of yellow apple, star fruit and white peach flavors together. Shows serious cut and drive on the finish, with a mouthwatering echo of dried fennel seed. Best from 2018 through 2022.

Montepeloso 2013 A Quo (Italy)
A little oaky on first nose, the 2013 A Quo is a robust red blend based primarily on Montepulciano, Cabernet Sauvignon and Sangiovese. The quality of the primary fruit is succulent, plump and rich. So are the background aromas of cinnamon, vanilla bean and toasted almond. This was a good vintage across Tuscany. The finish is exceedingly rich and supple with firmly yielding tannins. Give this wine a year or two to find greater harmony in the bottle. Those oak notes still need to integrate.
