SAUVIGNON BLANC (NEW ZEALAND)

Green papaya, lime and passion fruit flavors are intense and juicy on a sleek frame, with a touch of lemon verbena lingering on the finish. Drink now.

LIEVLAND 2017 CHENIN BLANC (SOUTH AFRICA)

Scents of honeycomb, beeswax and yellow melon abound on the nose of this wine, with some light sweet spice, baked apple and yellow flower accents. It's medium in weight, with ample acidity to lift the ripe orange, apple and pineapple core flavors and a slight prickle to the palate.

This dry gruner veltliner combines vibrancy with ripeness and weight, neither too round nor too crisp. Some nice herbal complexity adds interest at the clean finish. Drink now.

VALE DO BOMFIM 2019 DOURO TINTO (PORTUGAL)

The 2019 Tinto Vale do Bomfim Dow is 50% a field blend, 30% Touriga Franca and 20% Touriga Nacional, all aged for six months in an equal mixture of stainless steel and French oak (15% new for the half of the wine in wood). It comes in at 13.6% alcohol. A very solid wine and a nice bargain for the money, this touches all the bases, showing reasonable concentration, flavor and freshness. There's even a little firmness on the finish, although structure is not the biggest deal here. Still, this is a very respectable offering for a nice price.

KIR-YIANNI 2018 "CUVEE VILLAGES" NAOUSSA XINOMAVRO (GREECE)

The 2018 Naoussa Cuvée Villages is all Xinomavro aged for 12 months in used French oak (with 25% American). It comes in at 13.3% alcohol. Beautifully wrought in its style, this is silky and fairly tannic. It shows off acidity and plenty of pop and power on the finish. In its youth, the fruit is still assertive, but this is mostly about the structure and the texture.

CASA SILVA 2019 CARMENERE (CHILE)

Combining different grapes from Colchagua, Casa Silva makes this Carménère with pre- and post-fermentation maceration followed by 50% aging in oak. It is a dark reddish violet in the glass, with an herbal, minty nose over a base of blackberry and cassis. On the palate it is well defined and fleshy, featuring polished tannins and an intensely pleasurable flavor and structure that enhance the overall profile.

CASTELFEDER 2018 "GLEN" PINOT NOIR (ITALY)

The 2018 Pinot Nero Glen marries ripe black cherry with notes of savory herbs, earthy minerals and violet flowers to create a captivating display. It's cool-toned yet also quite elegant, with a bump of juicy acids that adds further vibrancy to the mix of red and black fruits. There's a seductive inner sweetness here that resonates throughout, while the expression remains wonderfully balanced and fresh, making for a fully satisfying glass of Pinot Nero. Without a hard edge in sight, the 2018 Glen is ready to please.
